The StoryPod App enables us to engage with 10 different stories from the JHC survivors' testimonies, as well as explore artefacts and photographic evidence surrounding their experiences. Survivors' personal stories enable us to engage with history and events that would otherwise be difficult to comprehend. They allows us to be reminded of the human tragedy behind the facts and statistics; that the Holocaust happened to everyday people, who after the war made Melbourne, Australia their home.

The JHC website is a treasure trove of resources, such as online exhibitions and testimonies.

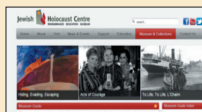
