

Our secondary school program (years 8–12) is designed to complement the Victorian curriculum and VCE and VCAL studies.



By meeting a survivor and through personal narrative, students are able to comprehend the enormity of the Holocaust. Students examine the unfolding of the Holocaust through the museums' collection.

Our expert Holocaust educators focus on engaging students to think creatively and critically. This enables students to make meaningful connections to ongoing injustice, racism and mass atrocities in today's world.

By prior discussion with our Education team, teachers can request the focus to be on specialised learning topics such as; Psychology Unit 2, Area of Study 2 or specific texts such as *Night* or *Maus*.
